## Main Lodge

Our main lodge is nestled amongst the birch and pine of the Northern Canadian Boreal Forest at the mouth of the Little Churchill River. This location is perfectly situated to fish the surrounding lakes and rivers of this region, where the great trophy pike fishing occurs.





We offer the full American plan with chef-prepared meals, guided services and housekeeping.

Accommodating only 16 guests per week, we take pride in providing you with great care and personalized service that can only be achieved in a smaller camp setting.

Here, we treat our guests as great friends - you'll never feel like you're just a number!



#### Once you arrive on our gravel airstrip after the 35 minute flight from Thompson, the lodge and cabins are just a short walk away.

We have cabins to accommodate 2-, 4- and 6-man groups and they all have breathtaking views of the lake, bathroom(s) with hot showers and 24-hour generated electricity.

Our cozy lodge is always open for you to come kick up your feet and relax by the fire, eat a warm meal and socialize with other guests, or just to grab a snack or ice for your cabin.

In 2010, we upgraded our boats to new
16 foot Alumarine Pro Guide Deluxe boats,
fully equipped with 30hp 4-stroke
Yamaha outboards, built in casting decks,
GPS tracking devices, first aid kits,
depth finders, floor boards,
padded swivel seats, rod holders,
drink holders, release cradles,
life jackets, paddles
and coolers.











### Pelletier Lake Outpost

This outpost camp is located on a small scenic island on the west end of Pelletier Lake.

Enjoy the breathtaking view of the sunsets and the peace and quiet of having the lake all to yourself.

With no roads, nor any other cabins, the only noise you hear is the occasional call of the local wildlife or the hum of your outboard motor.





Pelletier Lake Outpost is an easy, hassle-free outpost experience. Fishing on this lake is phenomenal and will keep you entertained all day long as this lake is known for its BIG trophy pike and golden chunky walleye. Our cabin accommodates 4 guests and is equipped with a BBQ, fully-stocked kitchen area, a propane fridge & stove, indoor shower, food and bedding.

A camp manager will meet you with supplies for the week. Once you're comfortable with everything, the place is all yours for the week. He will return at the end of your week to ensure that everything ran smoothly so that we can provide a continuity of excellence.









## How to get there

#### If you are flying...

If you decide to fly, Thompson MB can be reached by commercial flights with Calm-Air. First, you need to fly to Winnipeg MB, clear customs and then take the connecting flight up to Thompson the day before your trip start date.

#### If you are driving...

If you decide to drive, head north from Fargo, ND on the I-29 which becomes Highway 75 in Manitoba and leads straight into Winnipeg. Take Winnipeg's North Perimeter Highway 100 and head North on Highway 6 all the way up to Thompson (approx. 7 hours north of Winnipeg.)



#### Terms & Conditions:

Applicable sales taxes will be added to the cost of the trip. A deposit of \$500 is due within 7 days of the booking date and final payment is due by April 1st. All payments are in U.S. funds. Cheques can be made out to Dunlop's Lodge and sent to: Box 32, Grp 35, RR2, Ste. Anne, MB, Canada, R5H 1R2. Invoices will be sent out March 1st for the remaining balance due on April 1st. If your final payment is not received by May 1st, Dunlop's has the sole discretion to cancel the reservation and sell that spot to another party. Should a cancellation become necessary by either the guest (for any reason) or by Dunlop's (due to ice conditions), all payments and deposits are non-refundable but can be deferred to a later reserved date the same year. There are no refunds for no-shows. We strongly advise that you get travel insurance! We recommend Travel Guard at 1-800 -826-4919 or see www.travelguard.com/Sportsmans. It is the responsibility of the guest to cover themselves with trip insurance.
